# <u>Cases of enforced disappearances and extrajudicial killings in</u> <u>Balochistan in 2023</u>

For many decades, Pakistan has committed gross human rights violations in Balochistan. Enforced disappearances, extrajudicial killings, and the discovery of mutilated bodies of Baloch human rights defenders and socio-political activists are aspects of human rights violations. Various human rights organizations, including Human Rights Watch, reported that there had been an upsurge in the number of missing persons and mutilated bodies in recent months. According to data collected by the Baloch Human Rights Council (BHRC), enforced disappearances and the "kill and dump policy" had brought brutality in the province to an unprecedented level. From January 2023 to December 2023, a total of 416 people became the victims of enforced disappearances. 36 bodies of the missing persons were recovered in many parts of Balochistan with marks of torture and bullet wounds.

BHRC has verified these figures from different sources and the victims' relatives.

## Cases of enforced disappearances and extrajudicial killings in January 2023

**January 01, 2023**: The security forces picked up two students, Liaquat Saki Dad, and Bakhtiar Shafi Muhammad, from Turbat town, district Kech. Zohaib Raisani, a student, was picked up by from the Universal Complex in Quetta. They are still missing.

**January 04, 2023**: Hamid, son of Bijjar, a singer, is missing since January 4, 2024, after he was taken away from his home in Turbat, Kech.

January 05, 2023: Security forces took away Ahmed, son of Ashraf, and Babo, son of Hussain Ahmed, residents of Kolwah, from Askani Bazaar, Turbat.

January 07, 2023: Bilal, son of Ghafoor, and Umair, son of Dad Muhammad became the victims of enforced disappearances from Gomazi, Tump.

January 10, 2023: Raza Muhammad, son of Sher Muhammad Magsi from the Gazi area of Sibi was taken away. His whereabouts remain unknown.

January 13, 2023: Security forces picked up two brothers, Bijjar Hassan and Nauroz from Mand. They have been missing since.

**January 15, 2023:** Security forces picked up Abdul Khaliq, son of Ghulam Muhammad Qambrani, a tailor, from Irrigation Colony in Sariab Road, Quetta. He remains missing. Naqeeb Jamaldini, son of Khairullah Jamaldini, Adnan Jamaldini, son of Haji Akbar Jamaldini, Sufiyan Jamaldini, son of Haneef Jamaldini (a minor), and Muzamil were taken away from Noushki. Their whereabouts are unknown. From Hub city, Wazir Ahmed, son of Ali Jan, became the victim of enforced disappearances.

January 16, 2023: Subhan Qaisrani and Masood Ur Rehman Qaisrani, became the victims of enforced disappearances after security forces took them away in Quetta.

**January 19, 2023:** Security forces picked up three students, including Kiyya, son of Muhammad Ashraf; Atif, son of Muhammad Fazal; and Sher Khan, son of Sumar, from Quetta. Atif and Sher Khan were released a week after, while Kiyya remains missing.

January 25, 2023: Naseeb Ullah Shawani, son of Bakhtawar Shahwani, went missing after the Pakistani security forces took him away from Mastung Bazaar.

**January 26, 2023:** Security forces picked up Salam, son of Muhammad Azam, and Khuda Rahm, son of Mashki, near the Civil Hospital in Quetta. Their whereabouts remain unknown.

## Cases of enforced disappearances and extrajudicial killings in February 2023

**February 01, 2023**, Security forces arrested Afzal, son of Abdul Rahim, from Mashkay, district Awaran. He remains missing. Rauf and Ameer, residents of Dhadar, district Kachhi, were arrested and disappeared by the security forces from a hotel in Mastung.

February 02, 2023, Khuram Badini and Saud Badini went missing after the security forces arrested them from Nushki district.

**February 03, 2023**, Muhammad Rahim Zehri along with his wife Rashida Zehri and two of his minor children. Rashida Zehri was arrested by security forces. The children were released a few days later, but Muhammad Rahim Zehri remains missing.

February 04, 2023, Ali Nawaz, son of Muhammad Umar, from Mangochar, district Qalat was arrested by security forces. He remains missing.

February 05, 2023, Pakistani security forces abducted Wahid, son of Wali Dad, from the Maher area of Mand, district Kech.

**February 06, 2023**, Pakistani security forces picked up Dildar, son of Khudabadan and Khan Muhammad, son of Muhammad Ali from the Dandar area of district Kech. They were not seen after being shifted to a nearby military camp.

**February 07, 2023,** Gulab and Saleem were forcibly disappeared by Pakistani security forces in Gichk tehsil of district Punjgur in January 2023. However, their families made the incident public on February 07, 2023. They remain missing. Aurang Zaib, son of Siraj Ahmed, a resident of Panjgur, was picked up by the security forces from the Gulshan Mazdoor area of Karachi.

**February 08, 2023,** Shoaib, son of Muhammad Ayub, was picked up by the security forces from Mawach Bazar, Khudabadan area of district Panjgur. He remains missing.

**February 14, 2023,** Pakistani forces abducted Hasil, son of Abdul Samad, from his home in Mand, district Kech. Mali Marri, son of Faqeer Shad Marri, was picked up by security forces from Harnai, Balochistan.

**February 17, 2023**, Jungian, son of Mazar, along with his two sons, Waheed Ahmed, son of Jungian, and Naseeb Ullah, son of Jungian, and his brother-in-law, Karim Dad's son Manzoor Baloch, were abducted by Pakistani security forces from tehsil Gichk, district Panjgur.

On February 18, 2023, the security forces picked Sanjer, son of Wazir Ahmed, from Tasp bazaar, Punjgur.

February 20, 2023, Yahya Salam, son of Salam Baloch, a resident of Punjgur, was abducted by one of the death squads operating in the area.

**On February 22, 2023,** Pakistani security forces abducted five men from Jiwani, district Gwadar named Kamran, Nazeer Ahmed, Rashid, Abdul Qadeer and Faisal Baloch. Pakistani forces picked up two brothers, Dad Shah, and Saeed Ullah, from their house in the Dal Karki area of Mashkay, district Awaran. They remain missing. Faiz Muhammad and Hasil from their homes in the Taank area of Mashkay, district Awaran. They remain missing. Hameed Baloch, son of Abdein, a resident of the Allah Bakhsh Goth area of Jhaoo, district Awaran, was summoned by the Pakistani security forces to a military checkpoint in Kalatu, Jhaoo. The security forces took him away; he has not been heard from since.

February 26, 2023, Arshad, son of Naseer Ahmed, a minor, was abducted by the Pakistani forces during a raid on his family home in Gomazi, district Kech. He remains missing.

February 28, 2023, Meer Wais, the security forces on his home in Apsar, Kech. He remains missing.

### **Extrajudicial killings in February 2023**

February 05, 2023, Noor Ahmed, son of Abdul Ghaffar Kashani, a resident of Dalbandin, was shot and killed by Pakistani security forces in Mashkay, district Awaran.

**February 17, 2023,** The Pakistani army detained and tortured Dad Bakhsh, son of Miskan and resident of Awaran, at the Geshkor camp. He died due to brutal torture.

**March 01, 2023**, Muhammad Jan son of Hakeem Baloch, a teenage student from Turbat was picked up by the Pakistani security forces in Turbat, Kech. He has remained missing since. Waju, son of Wahab Baloch and Haseem, son of Shafi Muhammad were taken away by the security forces from Mand, Kech. They remain missing. Shehzad, son of Mir Jan Domki, a resident of Sibbi, Balochistan, was picked up by the security forces from Karachi. He remains missing.

March 06, 2023, Hameed Baloch, son of Babu Mehrab was abducted by the security agencies from Gwadar. His whereabouts remain unknown.

**March 07, 2023,** Pakistani security forces picked up two men from Gwadar. They were identified as Shah Jahan, son of Gamdad, and Waheed Baloch, son of Haji Feroz. Their whereabouts are unknown. The security agencies abducted Nazeer Ahmed, son of Bahram from Panjgur. He remains missing.

March 09, 2023, Shehzad, son of Bohair, and Faraz, son of Muhammad Iqbal both minors were picked up by the Pakistani security agencies from Aapsar, Turbat. They remain missing. The security forces abducted Muhammad Ibrahim, son of Nabi Bakhsh Mengal, and Nizam, son of Nabi Bakhsh Mengal from Harnai. They remain missing.

**March 10, 2023,** Security forces abducted Sabir, son of Abdul Ghani and Rasool Bakhsh, son of Taj Muhammad, from Gwadar. They remain missing. Javed, son of Ghulam Qadir, and Murad Ali were forcibly disappeared during a military raid on their family home in Hub, Balochistan.

March 12, 2023, Attaullah, son of Abdul Qadir, and Pazir Ahmed, son of Shambey, were abducted by the army-backed members of local death squad from Parom, Panjgur. They remain missing.

March 13, 2023, Security forces picked up Jalal, son of Meerain, and Israr, son of Attaullah from Tump. Jalal was released on March 20, 2023, but Israr remains missing.

March 15, 2023, Security forces abducted Amjid Ahmed, son of Ahmed Siapad, and Muhammad Qasim, son of Haji Karim Dad, from Raskoh Ari Kallag area of Kharan. The victims remain missing.

March 17, 2023, Asif, son of Allah Bakhsh, a resident of Jhaoo, was picked up by the Pakistani security forces from Teertaje area of Awaran. He remains missing.

March 18, 2023, the security forces forcibly disappeared Jumma Khan Marri and Roz Muhammad in New Kahan, Quetta. Their whereabouts are unknown.

March 20, 2023, Khalid, son of Muhammad Hassan and Asif, son of Abdulla, both students were picked up by the Pakistani security forces from Khuzdar. They remain missing.

**March 21, 2023**, Saddam and Kattu, were abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Kohlu. They remain missing. Jahanzeb, son of Fazal, was picked up by the Pakistani security forces from Turbat. His whereabouts remain unknown.

**March 23, 2023**, Rahmdil Baloch, son of Muhammad Ismail was abducted by the Pakistani security forces from the Jinnah International Airport in Karachi while he was boarding a plane for UAE. Bilal Zehri, son of Munir Ahmed was abducted by the security forces from Khuzdar. He remains missing.

March 25, 2023, Beebagr, son of Hafeez Ullah was forcibly disappeared by the security forces in Kharan. He remains missing.

**March 28, 2023,** Pakistani security forces abducted two students from Turbat. They were identified as Waris Mussa, a resident of Alandur, Buleda, and Yaseen Sahibdad, a resident of Pirandar, Awaran. They are still missing.

March 30, 2023, Nawaz, son of Shafi Muhammad, a student was picked up by the security agencies from Turbat. He remains missing.

#### **Extrajudicial Killings in March 2023**

March 05, 2023, Kifa Islam, a resident of Tump, was abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Tump on March 04, 2023. His tortured dead body was found a day later.

March 21, 2023, Allah Dad, was shot dead by the Pakistani security forces during a military operation in Kohlu.

Javed Zehri was released on April 15, 2023, but Ali Hassan's whereabouts remain unknown. Aziz Mazarzai, son of Muhammad Rahim Mazarzai, a resident of Kharan was abducted by the security forces. He remains missing to this date.

April 06, 2023, Sarfaraz Rakhshani, son of Azmat Ullah went missing after he was taken away by security forces from the new bus station in Quetta. Ibrar Jattak, a student, was picked up by the Pakistani security forces from Civil Colony in Khuzdar. He remains missing. Members of a local death squad abducted Sawal, son of Mehrullah, a shop keeper during a raid on his shop in Qalat district. Sawal remains missing.

**April 07, 2023**, Pakistani security forces picked up Shehzad Raisani, a student, and Jaleel Ahmed, a footballer from DPC College Football ground in Khuzdar. They remain missing. Two brothers Chalu and Izzat, sons of Maqsood were abducted by the Pakistani security forces during a military raid in Kulowa Segak Taank, district Kech. They remain missing. Shoaib Ahmed, son of Liaqat Baloch disappeared after security forces arrested him from Absor area of Turbat city.

April 09, 2023, Abdul Aziz, son of Abdul Hameed, a student, was abducted by the security forces from Khuzdar. He remains missing.

April 10, 2023, Security forces abducted Jalal, son of Hayat from Malir, Karachi. He remains missing. Hamad, son of Nazeer Ahmed was abducted by the security forces from Absor, Kech. He remains missing.

April 13, 2023, Shehzad, son of Abdul Wahid, was abducted by the security forces from Dazin, Tump area of district Kech. He remains missing.

April 14, 2023, Sher Zaman, son of Sharbat Khan and Shoaib Bangulzai, son of Ali Akbar Bangulzai, both students at the University of Balochistan, were abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Achakzai Plaza in Quetta. Sher Zaman was released on April 19, 2023, but Shoaib Bangulzai remains missing.

April 15, 2023, Dr Fayyaz Lashari was arrested from Pishin. He remains missing.

April 20, 2023, two students Shehzad Baloch, son of Mehrdil, and Zaheer Shah Khetran, son of Naveed Ahmed were picked up by the security forces in Rawalpindi, Punjab. They remain missing.

April 27, 2023, Rahid Baloch, son of Zahid Baloch, was abducted by security forces from his family home in Tump, Kech. His whereabouts remain unknown.

**April 30, 2023,** Basheer Ahmed, son of Taj Muhammad, a student, was picked up by the security forces from Nall, district Khuzdar. He remains missing.

**April 20, 2023,** Dead bodies of missing Farid Shahwani, son of Ghulam Mustafa, a resident o district Mastung, Azeem Khan, son of Yar Muhammad, a resident of Harnai, and Hazrat, son of Muhammad Khan Sumalani, a resident of Harnai were identified by their family members. Farid Shahwani was abducted by the Pakistani security forces in August 2022, while Azeem Khan and Hazrat were abducted by the security forces in March 2023. They remained missing until their dead bodies were brought to the Civil Hospital Quetta by the CTD police who claimed to have killed them in an encounter.

May 05, 2023, Murtaza Zehri remains missing after security forces arrested him from Khuzdar.

May 12, 2023, Pakistani security forces picked up Mujahid, son of Fazal during a raid on his family home in Bonistan area of Panjgur. He remains missing.

May 13, 2023, Ali Ahmad, son of Muhammad Gamshadzahi, was abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Wadh, Khuzdar. His whereabouts remain unknown.

May 18, 2023, Haseen, son of Muheem Jan, a musician, went missing after security forces arrested him from Chitkan area of Panjgur.

May 20, 2023, Pakistani security forces abducted Akhtar, son of Peer Muhammad during a raid on his home in Buleda. He remains missing.

**May 22, 2023**, five members of a family named Waseem, son of Haji Sharif, Yar Jan, son of Manzoor Ahmad, Ijaz Ahmad, son of Abdul Hakim, Ghafoor Ahmad, son of Abdul Hameed, and Abdul Basit, son of Abdul Hakim were abducted by the Pakistani security forces in Buleda, district Kech. They remain missing to this date.

May 26, 2023, Pakistani security forces abducted Numan, son of Ali Hassan from Jangiabad, district Khuzdar. He remains missing. Atif Jamaldini, son of Muhammad Hanif was abducted by the security forces from Jangalat area of district Nushki. He remains missing.

May 30, 2023, Security forces picked up two brothers from Chitkan area of district Panjgur. They were identified as Ilyas Dagarzai and Hafiz Karim, sons of Haji Noor Mohammad. Their whereabouts remain unknown.

**June 01, 2023**, Miran, son of Abdul Wahab, became the victim of enforced disappearances after security forces arrested him from Tump, district Kech. Mehraj Aslam, son of Muhammad Aslam, a student, was abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Karachi, Sindh. He remains missing.

**June 03, 2023**, two brothers Abdul Karim and Muhammad Ilyas, sons of Haji Noor Muhammad were picked up by the security forces from the Chitkan area of district Panjgur. Their whereabouts are unknown.

**June 05, 2023**, the security forces picked up three men from Kalar area of Mashkai, district Awaran. The victims were identified as Rahim Dad, son of Umaid Khan, Abdul Nabi, son of Muhammad Bakhsh, and Muhammad Azam, son of Atta Muhammad. Their whereabouts remain unknown.

Yasir, son of Gull Muhammad, was abducted by the security forces from Zehri area of district Khuzdar. He remains missing. Sakhi Bakhsh, a writer of Balochi literature was forcibly disappeared by the security forces in Turbat, district Kech. He remains missing. Feroz, son of Ikram Khetran, a labourer by profession, was picked up by the security forces from from Rawalpindi, Punjab. He remains missing.

June 06, 2023, Sajid, son of Khalid Ahmad was abducted by the security forces from Kulanch area of district Gwadar. He remains missing.

**June 09, 2023**, security forces picked up Sajid, son of Hameed at Lakpass, Quetta. He remains missing. **June 14, 2023**, security forces abducted Zakir, son of Rahmat, a blind man, and Waseem, son of Abdein from Bonistan area of district Panjgur. Their whereabouts are not known. Fateh Muhammad, son of Mayar, a student, was picked up by the security forces from Turbat, district Kech. Fateh Muhammad remains missing.

**June 15, 2023,** Muslim Arif, son of Arif Ghulam, a student, was abducted by the Pakistani security forces from Buleda, district Kech. He remains missing. Two brothers, Sajid Atta and Yahya Atta, from Sari Koran area of district Panjgur became the victims of enforced disappearances after they were picked up by security forces.

June 16, 2023, Muhammad, son of Mahmood and Asim, son of Muhammad Azum, both residents of Khuzdar were picked up by the security forces from Karachi, Sindh. Their whereabouts are unknown.

June 17, 2023, Qadir Bakhsh, son of Wajdad went missing after security forces arrested him from Gichk area of district Panjgur.

**June 18, 2023**, Lailah, son of Latif Ahmad was abducted by the security forces from Buleda, district Kech, He remains missing.

**June 21, 2023**, Abdul Wahab Qalandrani, a student, was picked up by the security forces from Khuzdar. His whereabouts remain unknown.

June 25, 2023, Shakoor Ahmad, son of Noor Khan from Pullabad, a resident of Tump, district Kech went missing after security forces arrested him.

**June 27, 2023**, Qadir Bakhsh and his son Niaz Ahmad were arrested by security forces in the Pirander area of district Awaran. Their whereabouts are unknown.

**June 01, 2023**, Zafar Ali, son of Sher Ali was abducted by the members of the local death squad from Mashkai, district Awaran. He was tortured to death.

**June 03, 2023**, the mutilated dead bodies of Jalal son of Yaqoob, and Adam, son of Shakir were found in the Nasirabad area of district Kech. According to the family sources of the victims, they were extrajudicially murdered by the security forces.

July 4, 2023, Salim Baloch went missing after he was arrested from Absar area of Turbat city. Muhammad Rizwan, son of Muhammad Ramzan, a resident of Khuzdar district, was taken into custody by security forces from Sariab Road in Quetta. His whereabouts remains unknown.

July 6, 2023, Salim Baloch from Faqeer Colony in Gwadar district was kidnapped by members of a death squad. He remains missing.

July 9, 2023, Farooq Ahmad, son of Abdul Hameed and a resident of Tehsil Tump, went missing from the Dazan area of Tump city after being picked up by security forces.

July 10, 2023, Pakistani forces ambushed the house of Barkat Ali, a schoolteacher and forcefully took the custody of his 17-year-old boy, Hikmat Ali who remains missing.

July 13, 2023, Ahmed Ali's son of Roshan Bugti remains missing after he was summoned in the military cantonment.

July 14, 2023, Security forces abducted Zahoor Ahmed, son of Jamm Khan and Azum, son of Allahdad from Brewery Road, Quetta. Both remain missing.

**July 16, 2023**, Sawa Gull, son of Ponal, Munshi, son of Roshen Bugti, and Hussain, son of Bakhtiar Bugti, are still missing after they were arrested by security forces from Dera Bugti. Shahid Baloch, son of Char Shambay, a student, went missing after he was taken away by the members of a local death squad from Turbat, district Kech.

**July 17, 2023**, Zahid, son of Dilbod, Wahid, son of Karim Bakhsh, and Imdad, son of Brahim, were detained by Pakistani security forces from the Pirander area of Awaran district. Their whereabouts are still unknown. From Dera Bugti, Dadain, son of Shahan went missing after security forces arrested him from the Sui area of Dera Bugti district.

**July 18, 2023**, Hasso Bugti, Marri Bugti, Khaira Bugti, Ahmad Ali, Inayath Ullah Bugti, Usman, and Sawal Bugti from Der Bugti area. Their whereabouts are still not known to their family members. Farooq, son of Murad Bakhsh, Peer Bakhsh, son of Baitullah, Sagheer Ahmed, son of Abdul Samad and Dad Rahim, son of Abdul Samad were kidnapped by members of a local death squad from Tump. All of them remain missing.

July 25, 2023, Muhammad Azeem, son of Muhammad Afzal went missing while he was traveling from his hometown to the main market in Awaran. He remains missing.

**July 26, 2023**, Shaid, the son of Abdul Hameed and a student from Gwadar district, was abducted by Pakistani forces from Gwadar city and remains missing.

July 27, 2023, Pakistani forces abducted Jabbar Aslam, son of Haji Aslam, Qamber Baloch, and Iltaf Baloch from Gwadar city.

**July 30, 2023**, Nisar Ahmad, son of Karim Bakhsh and a resident of Kalahu, tehsil Tump district Kech, was forcibly disappeared by Pakistani forces from Gwadar district in Balochistan. He remains missing to date.

July 31, 2023, Pakistani security forces abducted Noshad, son of Mia Dad Bojair, from Turbat city. He is still missing.

August 3, 2023, Ashraf, son of Ismail and a resident of Nukjo in Mashkai district, Awaran, was forcibly disappeared by Pakistani forces in Punjgur city.

August 7, 2023, Jungi Khan, son of Jan Muhammad, was pick up by Pakistani forces from the Teertaje area of Awaran district in Balochistan. However, no information has been provided regarding his whereabouts since.

August 9, 2023, Zareef Ahmad, a student, was detained by Pakistani forces from a shop in the Kolowai Bazar area of Kech district. His whereabouts are still unknown.

August 11, 2023, Sher Jan, son of Liaqat Amen was apprehended by Pakistani security forces in the Absar area of district Kech. Dad Shah, son of Sabar Khan, from Gresha Nall, district Khuzdar, was abducted by Pakistani forces from Maripur area of Karachi. From Karachi also, Pakistani security forces abducted Dr. Rafiq, son of Murad, who is a resident of district Kech, Balochistan. Faqeer Jan, son of Khuda Dost, from the Chitkan area of Panjgur was taken away by security forces from Karachi. Faqeer Jan is originally from Diz Parom in district Panjgur. The whereabouts of these arrested individuals are still unknown.

August 12, 2023, the whereabouts of Yahya Baloch, a student, who was arrested by security forces from Quetta, are unknown.

August 14, 2023, Qamber, son of Muhammad Karim, a student from Awaran, was abducted by security forces from Quetta and transferred to an unknown location. Kamaran Baloch, son of Soumar Baloch, a student from Khuzdar, was abducted by security forces from Khuzdar city. Jafar Nawaz, son of Nawaz Ahmad, was abducted by Pakistani forces from the Kili Jamadini area in Nushki. All three individuals remain missing.

August 15, 2023, Naveed Baloch a student went missing from Niya Abad area of Gwadar city. Zaman Baloch, son of Nawaz Ali was also forcibly abducted from Lyari, Karachi on August 15, 2023. He remains missing.

August 17, 2023, Nabi Bakhsh, son of Jan Muhammad, was abducted from his room in the A one city area of Quetta. He has remained missing since then. Samad Sasoli, from district Kharan, was abducted by security forces from Kharan city, and his whereabouts are still unknown. Asif Baloch was taken into custody Pakistani forces from Nushki district in Balochistan; his whereabouts also remain unknown. Shoaib Ali was taken into custody by Pakistani security forces from his residence, in Karachi's Singoline area of Sindh province. He is still missing.

August 19, 2023, Haq Nawaz, Hamid, Jafar, Umar, and Yaseen Baloch from Nushki district went missing after they were arrested by security forces.

August 20, 2023, Naeem Hasil, son of Hasil Khan, a resident of Kech district, was taken into custody by Pakistani forces from Karachi's Lyari area. His whereabouts remain unknown.

August 22, 2023, the whereabouts of Zaheer, son of Lashkaran; Peer Jan, son of Lashkaran; Adil, son of Asa Khan; Shah Jan, son of Atta; Ahmad Baloch, son of Shugurullah; Shoukat, son of Lewari; and Nabi Bakhsh, son of Lewari are still unknown after they were picked up by security forces from Turbat. August 23, 2023, Ijaz Ahmad from Mangochar area of Mastung district went missing after he was arrested by the security forces. Dad Rahim, son of Ilyas, became the victim of enforced disappearances after he was picked up Pakistani forces from Turbat in the Kahn Pusht area of Kech district, Balochistan. August 24, 2023, Naik Bakht, son of Fida Ahmad, was taken into custody by security forces from Shambey Ismail ward in the coastal city of Gwadar district, Balochistan. He is still missing.

August 25, 2023, Liaqat Bohar, son of Liaqat Ali, a student at Atta Shad Degree College in Turbat, went missing from Turbat city. His whereabouts are still unknown. Engineer Azrat Umar Nasir, a resident of Quetta district in Balochistan, was abducted during his journey from Islamabad to Quetta.

His whereabouts are also still unknown. Security forces abducted Faiz Muhammad and Hasil from their homes in the Taank area of Mashkay, district Awaran. They remain missing.

August 26, 2023, Meeran Khan, a student from Khuzdar district, went missing after he was picked up from the Jalawan Complex of Khuzdar city. Sajad Ali, son of Izzat Ali, and Muhammad Yousif, son of Muhammad Bakhsh, from Qambrani Road, Quetta went missing after their arrest by security forces.

August 27, 2023, Aman Ullah, son of Durr Muhammad Zehri from Khuzdar, was arrested by security forces from Anjira area of Khuzdar district of Balochistan and he remains missing.

**August 28, 2023**, Rasheed, son of Habib from Gwadar and a student, was abducted by Pakistani forces from Zahoor Shah Ward, Gwadar. M. Hassan, son of Akram Bangulzai from Quetta, was also abducted on August 28, 2023, by Pakistani security forces from Munir Ahmed Road, Quetta. The whereabouts of both individuals remain unknown.

Souri Bugti and his son Ali Dost, son of Souri Bugti went missing after they were picked up by security forces.

Sabeer, son of Sharif Ahmad, and Talim, son of Talib, two students from Panjgur district, were arrested from a snooker club in Gramkan Panjgur. Noor Muhammad, son of Dilmurad Bugti, Ali Muhammad, son of Dilmurad Bugti and Yar Khan, son of Shah Ali Bugti was arrested by security forces from Sui Ouch Tehsil of Dera Bugti district. Their whereabouts are still unknown.

September 21, 2023, Shezad Baloch, was taken into custody by security forces from the Government Boys High School in Mastani Rek Bazar, Tehsil Pasni Rekposht of Gwadar district. His whereabouts are unknown.

**September 25, 2023**, Adeel, son of Murad Jan, a resident of Panjgur district was taken into custody by security forces at the main gate of Jirek Border Parom and transferred to the military camp along with his vehicle. He has been missing since then.

**September 27, 2023**, Aslam, son of Faiz Muhammad Marri; Liaqat, son of Douz Muhammad Marri; and Abdul Khali, son of Jumma Khan Marri was arrested by security forces from New Kahan of Quetta district. **On September 8, 2023**, Raheem Dad, son of Umaid Khan, of Tehsil Mashkai in Awaran district a local death squad killed him on 8 September in Mashkai.

**On September 30, 2023**, Niaz Muhammad, son of Misk Ali Bugti, an internally displaced person was killed by members of a death squad in Karachi.

**November 26, 2023**, Javed, son of Babu Badal, was detained by security forces from his home in Nodwani Bazar, Jhal Jahoo area of Awaran district. He remains in army custody. From the same area, Mehmood, son of Fateh Muhammad, is also in the custody of security forces but they have not been produced in any court of law.

The victims, identified as Abdul Samad, son of Qasim and Noor Bakhsh, son of Sahib Dad were targeted in the villages of Bazdad and Peerandar in Awaran district, Balochistan.

**November 9, 2023**, in Khuzdar district of Balochistan, the Counter Terrorism Department (CTD) killed three missing persons in a staged encounter. The victims have been identified as Aftab, son of Jameel Ahmad Sumalani from Kili Goharabad area of Qutta, Hamza, son of Muhammad Ibrahim Shawani from district Washuk and Abdulla, son of Arz Muhammad from district Khuzdar.

**November 19, 2023**, on August 22, 2023, two brothers, Adil and Shah Jan, along with Nabi Dad, who were among the missing persons from Turbat, of Kech district, were killed by the Pakistan army using a car bomb in the Balgater area of Kech district.

**November 23, 2023**, the Counter Terrorism Department (CTD) police in Kech district have been implicated in the killing of four missing persons. Among the victims were Balach, son of Mula Bakhsh, who was abducted from his home in Absar Turbat, district Kech on October 29, 2023; Saifullah, son of Umaid Ali from Absar Turbat, district Kech, who was taken from his residence on August 1, 2023; Shakoor, son of Noor Jan from Pulabad area of Tump, who was detained in his hometown on June 25,

2023; and Abdul Wadood, son of Mubarak from Gareebabad Chitkan Panjgur, who was abducted from his hometown on April 27, 2023.

Chatta, son of Sahib Khan Marri, and Khair Jaan, son of Maher Marri, were arrested by security forces after being shot and wounded by a death squad from Kohlu district. The whereabouts of all the arrested people are not known.

**December 29, 2023**, Baden, son of Mustaq Qalandrani and Jibran, son of Lawang Khan were arrested from their residences in the Civil Colony area of Khuzdar district, by security forces. Their whereabouts are still unknown.

**December 30, 2023**, Saleem, son of Abdul Majeed, from the Kandari locality in Mashkai, Awaran district went missing after he was arrested by security forces.
